## 2019 - September

### **New Mexico Hemp Services** – *Santa Rosa, New Mexico*

Awarded **\$246,000** through JTIP to support the training of **17 new hires** at an average wage of **\$19.41 per hour**. SeedCrest facilitated the funding process, provided staffing support, and conducted tailored training programs for positions including lab technicians, extraction chemists, storage clerks, and an electrician. This funding helped establish a fully integrated hemp operation by the end of 2019.
